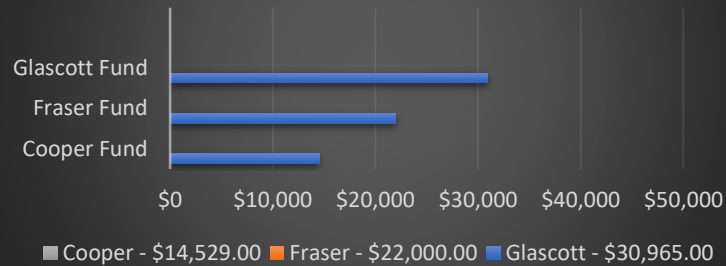




CAMP TECUMSEH

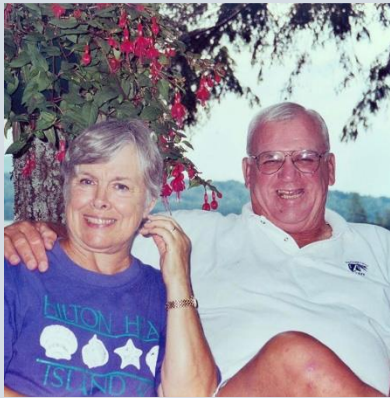
